

Terms and conditions

Limitations

1. The material has to be installed on the building within 12 calendar months after shipment from Corus Colors manufacturing works.
2. This guarantee includes the condition of the cut edges for the duration of the Colorcoat® LG Guarantee Period. In the long term, limited edge peel may arise from normal weathering at sheet overlaps and at eaves. In the unlikely event that edge peel is premature and deemed to be excessive, Corus will undertake to investigate and carry out any remedial action to ensure that the cladding system will be fully servicable at the end of the guarantee period. Cut edges are defined as those manufactured in factory-controlled conditions using conventional shearing procedures. Cut edges generated by alternative processes or on-site should be subject to best practice, including painting where necessary. Refer to Corus for guidance.
3. Corus Colors has to be notified by the profiler of a claim in writing within 30 days of the identification of any defect indicating a (potential) failure of the product meeting its performance criteria and, for any single plane, before 10% or 200 square metres of the paint surface, whichever is the lesser, is affected. Notification must include proof of the origin of the product including Corus Colors coil number and tracking information on the manufacturing and installation of the product.
4. Corus Colors obligation under this guarantee is limited exclusively to the cost of labour and material for restoring the defective panels to meet the original guarantee period. It will be at the sole discretion of Corus Colors as to what measures shall be taken to provide suitable restoration.
5. The warranty holds for buildings in the UK and Ireland.
6. Buildings should be maintained in line with Corus published literature.
7. The warranty applies only to deterioration of the weather side of the Colorcoat® LG product. Corrosion or other effects arising from elements within the building, corrosion from entrapment of pollutants within overlaps or from abnormal atmospheric pollution and contact with aggressive fumes or chemicals are excluded.
8. Installation, processing and use of the material has to be in accordance with the current product literature and published best practice at the date of sale.
9. The warranty is subject to English law.

Exclusions

1. Appropriate accessories and material have to be used to prevent any acceleration of corrosion of the weathering sheets.
2. Roofs with less than 4° degree pitch are excluded
3. Fabrication and/or installation of the coated material at temperatures other than indicated in the current product data sheet at the time of sale.
4. The performance of any touch-up paint or over-paint used on the panels is excluded.
5. Fire, lightning, flood, explosion, abnormal winds, earthquake, acts of war, riots, civil commotion, radiation, falling objects, vandalism and other extraneous causes.
6. Misuse, wilful act or negligence.
7. Damage to the sheets incurred during fabricating, storage, transport or erection.
8. Accumulations of dirt or debris nor does it apply to failure or damage in areas not exposed to washing by rainfall unless, in each case, the maintenance records should show clearly that these areas have been adequately hosed down at least annually.
9. Ponding on roofs and inadequately double sealed overlaps allowing retention of water and other contaminants.
10. Emissions of harmful gases, fumes or chemicals from either natural or man-made sources at or within 400 metres of the original erection site.
11. Exposure to continuous temperatures howsoever caused greater than stated in the product data sheet at the date of sale.
12. Deterioration caused by contact with wet, green or treated timber or due to direct or indirect contact with corrosive materials.
13. Any alteration or modification to Colorcoat® LG after erection.
